HEBREWS 11 - FAITH AT WORK

Moses and the Exodus – Exodus 2-12

- Look over the story line found in Exodus 2-12 for the story referenced in Hebrews 11:23-28 and/or watch the “creative story telling” video using the link provided.

- **Discuss with your kids the following truths:**
 - Hebrews 11:23-28 highlights the importance of faith in the story of Moses. Think about this, without faith:
 - Moses would have died as a child
 - Moses would have lived an easy life in Pharaoh’s house
 - Moses would never have come back to lead the people to freedom
 - Moses would never have been a part of the Passover
 - Moses would never have led the people out of Egypt
 - Faith in God changed everything about Moses’ life. When it comes time for us to think about our life and our life plans, faith can and should inform every part of our lives.

- **Questions:**
 - How did Moses’ family save his life when he was a baby?
 - What would life have been like for Moses if he had stayed in Pharaoh’s house as a relative of the king?
 - Why did Moses choose to suffer along with the other Israelites?
 - What do you think the Egyptians would have been saying about all of the plagues? Did they understand that the plagues were from God? Why did it take 10 plagues for Pharaoh to listen?
 - When the Israelites left Egypt, do you think they were excited to see what God would do next? In your life, when you follow God you can expect God to surprise you with the way he answers your prayers too!
